1. What We Have Done

1.1 Rebranding to the MFAc Student Association

We have initiated and made significant progress in rebranding the MFAc Student Society into the MFAc Student Association. This change reflects our commitment to expanding our scope, increasing our impact, and enhancing our service to the MFAc community. As part of this effort, we secured approval from the York University Graduate Students' Association (YUGSA) to formalize the name change. Our next step is to update the name on our Community Bank Account, which will allow us to operate officially as the MFAc Student Association.

1.2 Securing Financial Support

We successfully established a Community Bank Account, enabling us to apply for and receive the Operating Grant Fund (OGF) from YUGSA. The OGF provides essential funding that supports wellness workshops, social networking activities, and other events that enhance the student experience. Our efforts to secure financial resources have also included applications to the Student Wellness Initiative Fund and outreach to key stakeholders such as New College Head Zachary Spicer.

1.3 Building a Stronger Team

We have strengthened our leadership team by recruiting Xiangyue (Kevin) Kong as our Marketing Officer. Kevin's expertise in community engagement and event promotion is expected to significantly enhance our visibility and reach within the MFAc community.

1.4 Enhancing Event Portfolio

We have successfully organized various events, including wellness workshops, social networking activities, and professional development sessions such as job search strategy sessions and virtual industry meetups. These events provide students with opportunities to develop workplace awareness, skills, and industry insights.

1.5 Collaborating with MIAB

To increase the accessibility of resources, we have collaborated with the MIAB COM Coordinator and the MIAB EAB Coordinator to begin the development of an official website for the MFAc Student Association. This website will serve as a comprehensive resource hub for students, featuring event announcements, updates, and tools to support student development.

2. What We Are Doing

2.1 Developing the MFAc Student Association Website

We are currently collaborating with the MIAB COM Coordinator and the MIAB EAB Coordinator to build and maintain the official website for the MFAc Student Association. This website will act as a central platform for communication, event promotion, and community engagement.

2.2 Hosting the New Year Celebration Event

This change will allow us to fully operate under the new name and signal our expanded mission and scope.

3.1 Join the Student Community & Leadership Development (SCLD)

We plan to join the Student Community & Leadership Development (SCLD) next semester. Membership in the SCLD will enable us to access more funding from the Alumni Office and gain free access to York University's soccer fields for sports activities, reducing our operational costs and expanding our ability to host community-building events.

3.2 Secure External Funding

We will seek funding opportunities from external organizations outside of York University to diversify our financial support and create a more stable financial position for the MFAc Student Association. This will reduce our reliance on internal grants and create new revenue streams for future initiatives.

3.3 Launch the MFAc Student Association Website

Our plan is to officially launch the MFAc Student Association website in the coming semester. This website will serve as a key communication tool for the MFAc community, promoting events, publishing updates, and offering student support resources.

3.4 Increase Sports and Cultural Activities

With the anticipated membership in the SCLD, we will expand our recreational offerings by organizing sports activities using York University's soccer fields.
